#### Traralgon Lions Tribute to Allan L Vickery

Stallholders would recognise Allan as the father of Traralgon Farmers Market. There is no doubt that Allan laid the groundwork for our successful market.

However, Allan's community efforts went far beyond the Farmers Market. In Traralgon Allan was a driving force in the following community projects: Carols by Candlelight, Australia Day Breakfast, Senior Citizens Christmas Party, Traralgon's Soundshell, All Abilities Playground and Doorty Park. Allan was also a Latrobe City Citizen of the Year. Allan also received numerous awards during his time as a Lion.

Upon Allan's passing, Traralgon Lions Club members sought long term ways to recognise Allan's contribution to the community. During Allan's illness he underwent rehabilitation at Latrobe Regional Hospital. Unfortunately the hospital did not provide onsite beds for rehabilitation patients, but contracted out accommodation in Moe.

Two Lions members visiting Allan, recognised that this created problems for family members, wishing to visit rehabilitation patients.

Traralgon's Yallambee Village for the Aged (a not for profit organisation) is currently undergoing expansion and renovation. Yallambee are seeking to house rehabilitation patients from Latrobe Regional Hospital.

Traralgon Lions Club have undertaken to furnish one ward of 7 Bedsits and a sitting room and one ward of 6 Bedsits and a sitting room. The 7 Bedsit ward will be named the "Allan L Vickery Wing" and the 6 Bedsit ward the "Lions Club of Traralgon Wing" Suffice to say this comes at significant cost - in excess of \$85,000.

Allan's name will be remembered by the naming of the ward and hopefully Traralgon rehabilitation patients will be accommodated in their home town.

This June 2016 market is my last market as Market Manager. I officially retire from Lions this month and also as market Manager.

I have enjoyed working with Stallholders to arrive at what is a popular and I believe, a well-run market. I served my time as Allan's apprentice and only took over when Allan was no longer able to continue.

My thanks to all stall holders for their assistance and friendship over the years. May you all continue to support our market, be happy and of course profitable as well.
