CHANGES ARE COMING TO THE MARKET

As we previously advised, we have to get off the grass as the traffic is killing both the trees and the grass.

As of the next market, Saturday 24/9/16, we will be closing off East Bound side of Kay St to traffic and we will be using the service centre (Northern) side for stall holders plus the small carpark off Kay Street. The other half of the market will be using the Fire track on the Church (Southern) side.

Since all stallholders will now be setting up on bitumen, you will need suitable weights that will secure your Gazabo in windy conditions. If you don't have them you cannot put it up ,talk to Fred or Geoff.

All these changes are coming at a considerable cost to close of the road, signage etc. so stall fees will be raised by \$5 next month. Fred & Geoff will be discussing this and the lay out with you all during the course of the day.
