MARKET REPORT

Last market after talking to stall holders, several said that they had a great day, so let's hope its as good today and that the weather is good to us.

As you know, over the last couple of Markets we have had some issues with the council over vehicles parked on the grass areas. This has now been settled, with confirmation that they were happy with the way we set it up.

The result is that we can park the front of the cars on the grass, provided that the front wheels are parked on rubber mats. These mats need to be at least 1mtr long, and the actual wheel is not to be on the grass at any time.

We need to manage the market area without doing any damage to the grassed areas and this is a must with the wet weather coming. We have a few mats for loan only, so see Fred or Geoff. Otherwise it will be **YOUR RESPONSABILITY TO SUPPLY THEM**. They need to be of solid rubber and at least 1 metre long.

We still need to re think as to who can do without their cars on site as the actual stall site is only 4mtrs vs the average vehicle length of 5 to 6 metres.
