Who are the Traralgon Lions?

The Traralgon Lions Club are a band of dedicated men and women who volunteer their time to help raise funds to be able to help the needy. We are a club of 32 members with ages ranging from 42yrs to 89yrs young. They come from all walks of life from Doctors, Chemists, Insurance, Finance, Cinema projectionist, Truck Drivers, Retirees, etc.

Despite the greater number of members being over 65yrs of age, we still manage to run a number of major yearly projects, including the Farmers Market, a Spinning Wheel at the Plaza each Saturday morning, an Australia Day Breakfast in Victory Park where we feed up to 1500 people with toast, bacon, scramble eggs and sausages, cereals tea coffee o/juice, a Charity Golf Day, a senior cits Xmas party for approximately 260 people and Carols by Candle Light at Victory Park with up to 6000 people in attendance.
