When you signed the application you agreed that you had read our Market Charter and would abide by the rules. These rules include starting and finishing times (8am to 1pm).

You MUST be set up by 7.45am and you <u>CANNOT</u> leave before 1pm. This is important if for no other reason than customers are wandering the market and we do not want any accidents between vehicles and people.
